WCSA MINI Tournament Rules

***COACHES:** Please check-in at the registration area, before your first game so that we know your team has arrived and to pick-up your team "loot bag", which includes lunch tickets and tokens for you and your players. ***Players should go directly to their scheduled field.**

U7, U8, U9 & U10 - Played on Mini-Field (7vs7)

- Ball size #4
- Each team shall have 7 players on the field, one of whom is a goalie.
- Each game consists of two halves of twenty-five (25) minutes with a five (5) minute interval between halves. Teams will change ends at half time.
- **NO** injury time will be added and **NO** late start time will be added. All teams **must** be **ready to play at the scheduled times so as not to delay the next** games.
- There will be no overtime or penalty shots.
- There are no score sheets and no scoreboards.
- A player will receive two (2) attempts at a throw-in, then the opposing team will take the throw-in at the referee's direction.
- All free kicks are indirect kicks.
- No slide tackling is allowed.
- Substitutions are allowed at any time expect corner kicks.
- Referees will stop the game immediately when a player is injured.
