WCSA Youth Tournament Rules

***COACHES:** Please check-in at the registration area, before your first game so that we know you have arrived and to pick-up your team "loot bag", which includes lunch tickets and tokens for you and your team. ***PLAYERS should go directly to their field.**

U15, U16, U17, U18 -- 11v11 on a full field

- Ball size #5
- Each team shall have 11 players on the field, including the keeper.
- The Home team will wear pinnies or provide alternate colour shirts if there is a conflict in uniform colours.
- A game consists of two halves of twenty-five (25) minutes with a five (5) minute interval between halves.
- Teams will change ends at half time - NO injury time will be added.
- All games will start and end on time, there will be no overtime.
- There are no score sheets or scoreboards.
- Substitutions are allowed at half time, when a goal is scored, a throw-in, a goal kick, or if a player is injured.
- Referees will stop the game immediately when a player is injured.
- No slide tackling is allowed.
- All other rules of soccer apply accordingly.
